In the name of the Jewish Community of the Tyrol and Vorarlberg I would like to thank you and the European Jewish Fund for the contribution to our Community for the year 2008.

Your generous grant was used for an array of activities, ranging from religious celebrations as a Bar Mitzvah to social support of two single mothers and a Russian widow with their families.

In addition, it enabled us to have our second Thora scroll repaired by a "sofer" in Vienna.

A substantial part of the money was spent on the Commemoration of the 70th Pogrom night ("Crystal night") in Innsbruck. In this ceremony we could raise awareness amongst our Tyrolean fellow citizens of this night, which had a particularly murderous course in Innsbruck.

More than 400 people attended the commemoration which was supported by many dignitaries from the political and academic scene as well as Catholic Church. Additionally, on the same day, a new monument for the discriminated, expelled and murdered Jewish professors and students of the medical faculty in Innsbruck in March 1938 was raised and inaugurated by the Chief-Rabbi of Austria.

Please find attached some pictures illustrating how much your financial support helped us in our community's recent activities. We are very grateful for your contribution allowing our community to carry out its social and religious tasks.
